SKI NEWS!

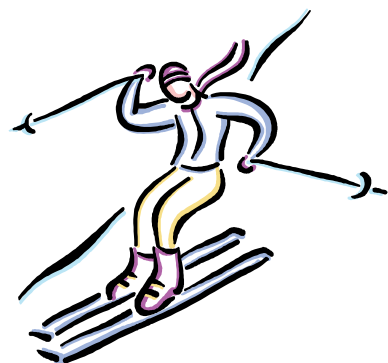
