On Sunday 21st March, our equestrian team are hosting a dressage competition at Reaseheath College, Nantwich.

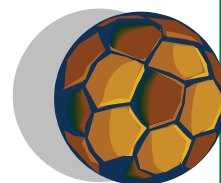
